- The Fire Prevention Poster Program is open to **ALL** students in **4th & 5th** grade
- You must create a Poster with your own, original artwork that **represents Fire Safety & Prevention** – bright, fun, easy to read & understand. It should convey a simple, effective & important message that anyone can grasp! Use the information you've learned from your fire safety education!
- Poster **MUST** include the following wording:

“Fire Prevention - Everyone/Everyday”

- Paper size must be 12”x18” (heavyweight or cardstock type preferred)
- **Correct spelling is required** – please spell check with a parent or teacher before submitting. Misspelling can result in being disqualified!
- Once done, hand your poster in to your teacher or principal so they can submit it to your local fire marshal by Friday, December 11, 2026
- **Most important, HAVE FUN and remember to share fire safety & prevention with your family, friends and neighbors! YOU are the most important tool for preventing fires!**
